

BUTCHER BLOCK TABLE

Build a Butcher Block table just like the Pro's use —
Let one of our trained staff help show you how easy it can be.

LIST OF NEEDED STEPS:

1. Determine where table will be placed.
2. Develop your design by studying Books and Magazines for ideas.
3. Remember your design and size of the table should fit your location.
4. Develop your material list from design or drawing.
5. Make a cut list showing each piece.
6. Select material to be used.
7. Start by cutting each piece, some sanding should be done prior to assembly.
8. Next laminate Table top pieces together (Remember to alternate the annular growth rings every other piece to help keep Table top flat).
9. Next scrape off excess glue from each row of lamination, then sand each piece starting with a Medium grit sandpaper (120) and "step" your way to a Fine grit (220).
10. Start assembly on flat surface such as a workbench or Garage floor.
11. After assembly Table should be final sanded.
12. Apply Butcher Block Finish according to Manufacturer's instructions.
13. Allow to dry and you're done.
