

CEDAR SHED ASSEMBLY

Let Southern Lumber help you regain lost space in your home with a Pre-Fab storage shed.

LIST OF NEEDED STEPS:

1. Measure area where you want your new shed.
2. Choose the size and style of Shed.
3. Make sure shed will fit intended space.
4. Carefully read manufacturer's instructions.
5. Start by making sure site location has been leveled, if not level. (Shed can be installed over a gravel bed, Concrete slab, or Pier block and beam).
6. Place Pre-fab floor into proper location (be sure to allow for Roof overhangs).
7. Now stand up the back wall and 1 side wall, and secure together with screws provided into pre-drilled holes. Continue process until all four walls have been secured together.
8. Once ALL four walls have been screwed together move walls so they overhang the floor equally on all 4 sides, and fasten walls to floor.
9. Now lift 1 Roof section into place, align with ends of shed, and screw in place.
10. Lift other Roof section into place and secure with screws.
11. Apply provided flashing to seal against leaks.
12. Once Shed has been assembled it's ready to use.
13. Option: Stain and seal or let Cedar naturally weather.
