

## CLOSET DOOR REPLACEMENT

Let Southern Lumber Company help you “Cut” the cost of cabinet door replacement using various types of sheet goods.

### LIST OF NEEDED STEPS:

1. Carefully measure opening (Be sure to take 2-3 measurements in width & Length due to wall irregularities).
2. Select style of new doors (Custom sizes are available).
3. Place your order - some styles in stock (Special orders allow 1-3 weeks).
4. Southern Lumber can deliver it for you to make it easier.
5. Determine if new doors need to be finished, If so proceed onto Prepping the doors to be finished.
6. Next remove existing doors and Track.
7. Start by installing Top Track (Usually some cutting will be necessary for correct fit).
8. Use a “Plumb Bob” to find proper location for bottom track or guides.
9. Next Hang doors.
10. Adjust rollers so that doors fit properly with the “Plumb” of your walls.
11. Install Knobs or Pulls.
12. Clean-up area.
13. You’re done.
