

CURIO CABINET

LIST OF NEEDED STEPS:

1. Do research by exploring different literature to gather design ideas.
2. Create drawing or sketch detailing basic size and shape.
3. Develop a material "Cut List" from drawing.
4. Consider having the material cut to size by one of our trained professionals inside our mill.
5. Select needed materials including the lumber, fasteners, and Decorative hardware and fittings.
6. Determine what type of finishing materials will be needed (Primer and Paint or Stain and Finish).
7. Start with side pieces. Attach one side to top with glue and finish nails.
8. Attach second side to top with glue and finish nails. Apply a bead of glue to each shelf, and fit into place.
9. Check as you go to insure that cabinet is being kept in square during assembly, once square clamp across the face and back and allow glue to set over-night.
10. Once assembly is complete, Step sand the entire cabinet, tack cloth dust particles, and start to apply finish.
